Pure Stock Classes
2800, 3200, 3500, 4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6000, 7000, and 8500

Farm Stock Classes
3750, 4250, 5250, 6250, 7250, and 9250

Improved Classes
3750, 4000, 4500, 5500, and 6500

Modified Classes
3750, 4000, 5000, and 5500

General Tractor Rules

1. Tractors must have Fenders.
2. No using torque amplifiers or other shifting on the go.
3. Driver must remain on the seat with one hand on the steering wheel at all times. No Jumping or Bouncing, Leaning will be acceptable.
4. Operators MUST follow flag man's signal. Front end height will be judged by flag man.
5. Anything that falls off of a tractor, weights, etc. is an automatic disqualification.
6. Going out of bounds on the track will result in a red flag and a recorded distance from the out of bounds.
7. Any operator between the ages of 14-17 must have a parent/guardian sign the waiver and must also have a tractor safety class. NO EXCEPTIONS
8. Add on weights must not exceed 11 feet from the center of the rear axle or 24" beyond the center of the rear axle. Please keep weight attaching threaded rod lengths to a minimum for everyone's safety.
9. Three Hooks per tractor. May change depending on the quantity of tractors at pull.
10. Track judges' ruling is final.
11. Any puller who complains about another's tractor must be competing against that person. The person who has issue with another's tractor may be inspected as well. Anything questionable will be up to track officials to judge. Their say is FINAL.
12. Steel wheel tractors will pull last in their class.
13. No alcohol or other drugs while operating tractors or other equipment.
14. All tractors in all classes will be allowed a 100lb overage.

PURE STOCK

1957 and Older

Stock block, head, manifold, carburetor. Stock hp and Rpm's.

3.5 Mph Speed limit. Horn may honk once within the first 75 feet.

Wheel weights or factory weights in factory locations. Any weight bracket must be empty.

Factory drawbars only. 18" hitch height.

No Cut or Sharpened Tires. 13.6 tire size limit for 4000 and under. 15.5 tire size limit in 4500. 18.4 tire size limit in all larger classes.

No Oliver 88, Massey 44, Farmall M, Minneapolis U, John Deere G, etc below 5000lbs.

Tractor must run on the original fuel that they were designed for. Gasoline, diesel, L.P. Naturally aspirated or factory turbochargers only.

Tractors must appear stock. No aftermarket fuel tanks, lightweight front ends, aluminum wheels, etc.

FARM STOCK

1965 and Older.

Stock Block, head. Stock RPM.

3.5 Mph Speed limit. Horn may honk once in the first 75 feet.

Wheel weights and hang weights are allowed.

18" hitch height, 18" behind rear axle. Wheelie bars required when not pulling from factory drawbar.

NO cut or sharpened tires. 18.4 tire size limit.

Tractor must run on original fuel it was designed for. Gasoline, diesel, L.P. Naturally aspirated or factory turbochargers only.

IMPROVED

1965 or Older

Engine block of same number of cylinder and original manufacturer only. Tsc John Deere power blocks are allowed.

4.0 Mph Speed limit for 3750, 4000 and 4500 classes.

5.0 mph speed limit for larger classes. Horn may honk once in the first 75 feet.

20" Hitch height, 18" behind rear axle. Wheelie bars required when not using a factory drawbar.

Naturally aspirated or Factory turbochargers only.

Cut or sharpened tires are allowed. 18.4 tire size limit.

Over 20% on Rpm's must have proper safety equipment.

MODIFIED

Pullers must be 18 years of age or older

1965 or older

Block must be same number of cylinders and made by same manufacturer as original. Tsc John Deere power blocks are allowed.

7.0 Mph Speed limit. Horn may honk once in the first 75 feet.

20" Hitch height, 18" behind rear axle. Wheelie bars Required, kill switch also required.

Cut or Sharpened Tires are allowed. 18.4 tire size limit.

Over 20% on Rpm's must have proper safety equipment
